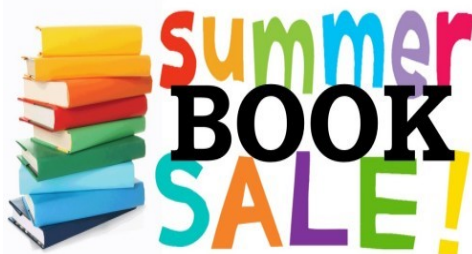

| JUNE 15 thru JULY 27 | 8- 9:00 AM

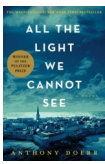

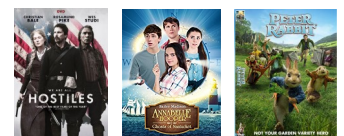
