The Noble County Public Library has recently partnered with the Albion Parks Department, the Avilla Parks Department, and Merry Lea Environmental Learning Center to bring three StoryWalks® to the Noble County area!

A StoryWalk® is a fun interactive activity that places a children's story, page by page, along a walking path. StoryWalks® were created to inspire parents, teachers, and caregivers to take children outdoors and combine physical activity with learning.

Library staff members will maintain the StoryWalks® and swap out the storybooks every few months so children and families can enjoy a new book.

The three StoryWalks® are located at Hidden Diamonds Park in Albion, Ley Street Park beside the Library in Avilla, and at Merry Lea Environmental Learning Center.


